
2 Starting up interpreterQ

To start up the interpreterQ software:

- 1. Start the teacher computer.
- 2. Log in to the teacher computer with the user account you received from the university.
- 3. If the ICC ("Interpreter Control Center") does not start automatically, start the application by double-clicking the ICC icon.



4. If you want to use a different user interface language than that of the computer, you can change it by clicking the **Account** icon:



5. If no student PCs are started up, you can start them using the Power button in the ICC header:

3 Logging in for students

When the students arrive in the booths they can log in with their Windows account. Once logged in, the student PC desktops become visible in the ICC classroom view and the student names appear on the booth representations.
